

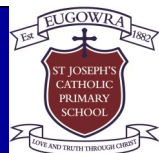

### LITTLE JOEYS TRANSITION

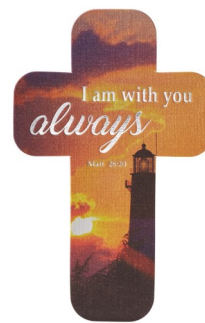
Yesterday was the last day for Little Joeys to visit for transition. Thank you to the Preschool for bringing the little ones over and to Mrs Crosby for hosting the program.

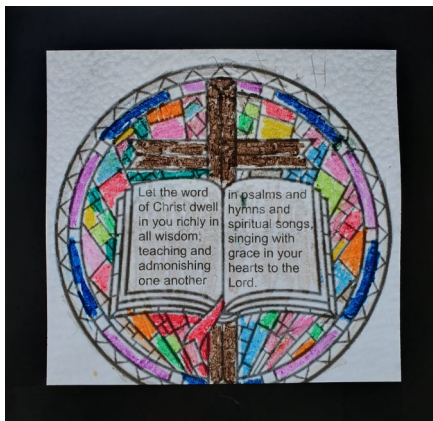

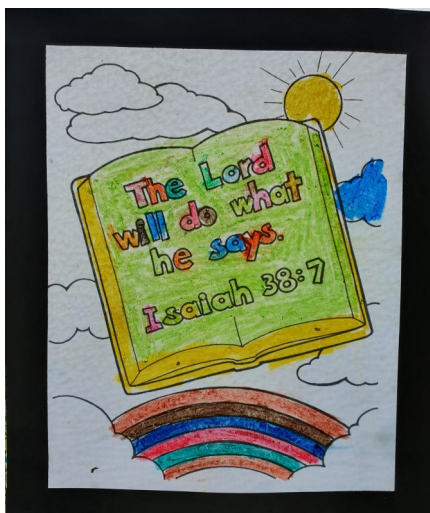
