CIRQUE UM NAVIGATE @ HOMEWORK CLUB




We are excited to be welcoming Cirque Um Navigate to St Joseph's!! You may have seen them performing magic and walking on stilts at the Eugowra Show last year.

ZONES OF REGULATION

As part of our Health and Personal Development Curriculum in 2025 we are implementing the Zones of Regulation Program in all classes.
