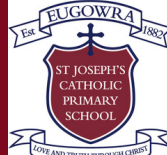

## IMPORTANT NOTES & REMINDERS:

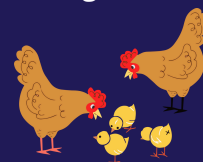
- **Annual School Improvement Survey:** The survey has been distributed; please complete it as your feedback is crucial for enhancing the school.

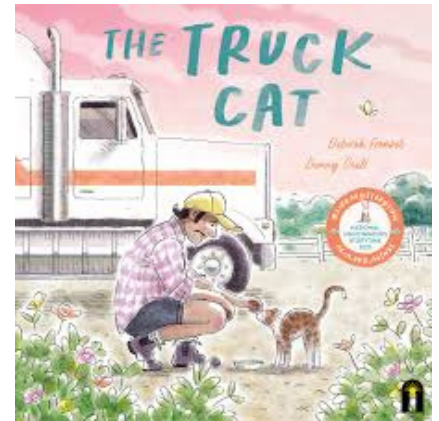
