We received the message below from the President of Floodplain Management Australia, Sue Ribbons:

First of all, congratulations and thank you once again to St Joseph's Catholic Primary School for the fantastic contribution you made to Floodplain Management Australia's annual National Conference held in Melbourne a couple of weeks ago. As you might have heard, we had 485 registrations at our conference and Rosemary, Zac and Sam certainly wowed them all as they spoke about their flood warning system they designed for their town of Eugowra. It was an absolute pleasure to host them at our conference. They are a credit to your school and your community.

We have also received an email from Aquamonix Solutions, who met Mrs Rose, Zac and Sam at the FMA conference. They are donating a sensor with web-based data access to help enhance monitoring capabilities of the creek. There will be community consultation to determine the best placement for this sensor.

We are beyond proud of our STEM MAD team, and are excited to see that ideas from our little school can really Make a Difference to our community.

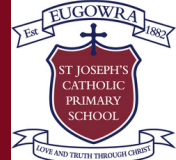

IMPORTANT NOTES & REMINDERS:

• Whooping Cough Alert

Confirmed cases are in the school community; parents should monitor for symptoms like prolonged coughing or a "whoop" sound. If symptoms occur, contact a healthcare provider and keep symptomatic children at home.

• If your child tests positive:

- Notify the school or childcare center.
- Keep them home for five days post-antibiotics or 21 days after cough onset.
- Avoid contact with infants and pregnant women.
- Antibiotics are effective in early stages and reduce transmission; after five days of treatment, individuals are no longer infectious.

• Uniforms

Children are to be dressed in full school uniform at all times, including ties and school hats (no caps). Ties and hats can be purchased from the office. Black school shoes must be worn. Thank you.
