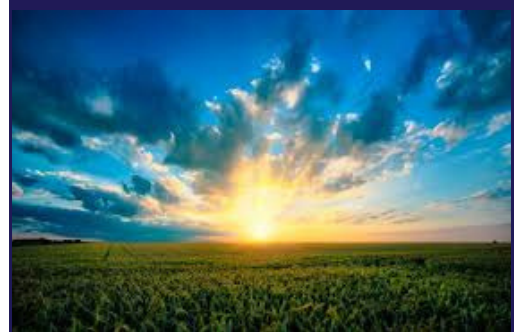

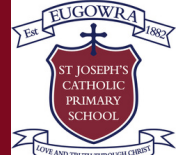

IMPORTANT NOTES & REMINDERS:

• Whooping Cough Alert

Confirmed cases are in the school community; monitor for symptoms like prolonged coughing or a "whoop" sound. If symptoms occur, contact a healthcare provider and keep symptomatic children at home.

If your child tests positive:

- Notify the school or childcare center.
- Keep them home for five days post-antibiotics or 21 days after cough onset.
- Avoid contact with infants and pregnant women.
- After five days of Antibiotic treatment, individuals are no longer infectious.

A reminder we have a clothing pool at school if you require any extra school uniforms. School ties are \$25.55 and hats are \$20. These can be purchased via the front office. Thank you.
