Online Parenting Group

Online parenting groups are for parents & carers who would like to:

- Understand their child's emotional needs by learning about their emotional needs
- Support their child's ability to successfully manage emotions
- Improve communication and strengthen the bond with their child
- Share ideas and experiences with other parents and learn new parenting approaches



We are offering new programs: Circle of Security and Tuning in to Kids.

What is a Circle of Security?

The Circle of Security Parenting Program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-child relationships are essential for a child's emotional and psychological development. The Circle of Security Parenting Program is a best suited for parents/carers of children aged 5-16 years old who are struggling with their child's emotional and behavioural issues.

What is Tuning in to Kids?

Tuning in to Kids (TIK) is an evidenced based, emotion focused parenting course that supports parents/carers to understand their child's emotions and their child's emotional needs. It is based on research in child development and child psychology.

Who is it for?

We are delivering TIK & CoS as part of our Community Recovery Service available to parents/carers of children aged 5-16 years old.

Camden, Cumberland, Coffs Coast, Byron, Cumbacha, Scone, Valley, Coffs Coast, and Murrumbidgee

Where?

Groups will take place online via Zoom. Access to stable internet, a computer/mobile, and a private space will be required.

When?

Running normally, we usually offer a group each school term.


