- wear bright-coloured clothing such as a vest so other road users can see them.

NASA has released that there is life past earth, and far more advanced than we would have ever guessed. In their exact words;


"The James Webb telescope has recovered signs of life on the exoplanet K2-18b having small algae like plants that have a tint of blue

NASA having found this, many other space related companies such as SpaceX, Blue Origin and Virgin Galactic have had quite an interest in




