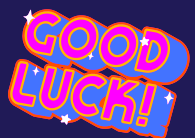
PRAYER

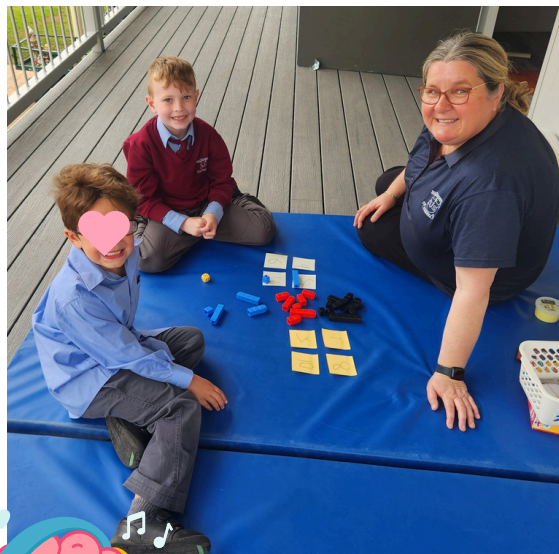
