On Tuesday 4th November, Steve our sports consultant from the CEDB, came to speak with our children about the significance of road safety. He emphasised the importance of being vigilant and aware when near roads, whether walking, cycling, or being a passenger in a vehicle. Steve engaged the students with interactive activities, including videos and dancing, role-playing scenarios and quizzes, to reinforce key safety messages. He highlighted crucial points such as using pedestrian crossings, wearing helmets, and understanding traffic signals. By the end of the session, they had a clearer understanding of how to stay safe on the roads and became more confident in their ability to make smart choices in various situations.

Amen.

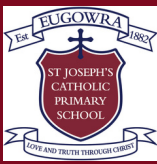

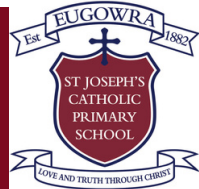
